### BOARD MEETING NOTES

Beginning January 1, 1980 Dave is to be paid a fixed monthly salary, rather than an hourly wage. The board feels that this is more consistent with the career professional character of the Head Coach position, and Dave concurs. He will be spending an average of 20 hours/week in on-deck coaching (Monday - Friday) except for vacation and sick-leave periods. Benefits, in addition to health insurance, include one day/month sick leave, 10 paid holidays, and 3 weeks paid vacation/year. This arrangement should also result in an improved ability to project our largest budgeted expense, the payroll.

As of January 1, 1980 there were 238 active members and 32 persons on leave. By January 8 there were approximately 20 more late enrollments and new members. If the club averages 250 members this quarter, paying \$14/month dues or \$42 per quarter, the income from dues will be \$10,5000. Based on the projected 1980 budget, quarterly expenses of \$13,000 will be incurred. So, the club needs to develop an outside source of income in order to break even each quarter.

### POOL COVERS TO ARRIVE SOON

The pool covers the club ordered are expected to arrive by Saturday, January 19. This should eliminate one prime excuse for not swimming on these wintry days!

### DAVE "IRONMAN" SCOTT TRIUMPHS IN HAWAII

Our head coach is now the bearer of the world's "Iron Man" title. To win this Dave competed in a field of 111 persons in a triathlon that would stretch anyone's imagination: 2.4 mile swim off of Waikiki Beach, a 112 mile bike ride around Oahu, and a 26 mile, 385 yard marathon.

Dave completed the course in a record 9 hours, 30 minutes, beating last year's record held by Tom Warren of 11 hours, 15 minutes.

A group of fans greeted David at the Sacramento Airport the night of January 14.
